

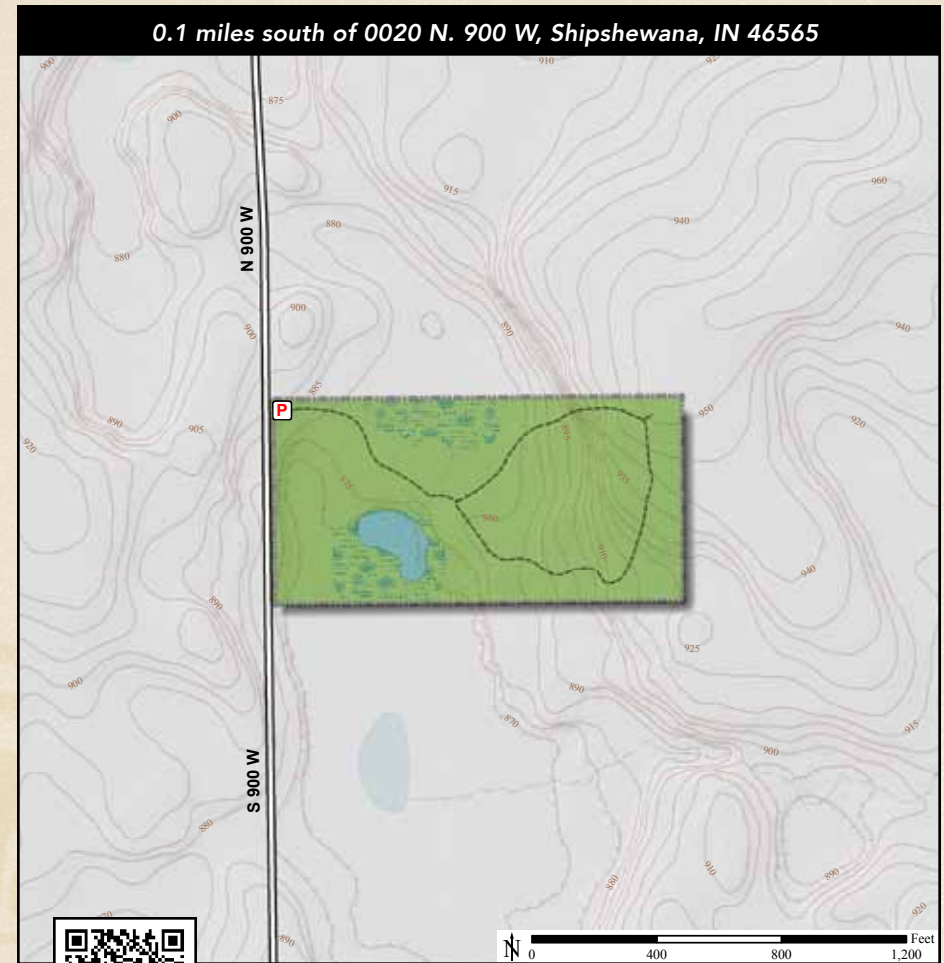


ACREAGE: **20.0** | YEAR ACQUIRED: **2003**

This is a woodland noted for its varied topography and great variety of wildflowers. Visitors may see blossoms of puttyroot, blue cohosh, creeping euonymous or heart's-a-busting, sharp-lobed hepatica, wild ginger, Jack-in-the-pulpit and wild leeks. There are also sensitive fern and at least five varieties of sedge.

From LaGrange at US 20 and SR 9, take US 20 west 9.75 miles to 900 W and turn left (south). Travel 1.0 miles to the preserve on the left. Parking area is 0.1 miles south of 0020 N. 900 W, Shipshewana, IN 46565.
